Summer Residential Workshop August 7-14, 2011

This year's workshop is geared toward both novice and experienced graduate students, teachers, professors and others from around the world who have interest or experience in using the Philosophy for Children curriculum and methodology.

In this workshop participants will experience and practice facilitating a "Community of Philosophical Inquiry" with adults, cultivate a "philosophical ear" by learning to recognize philosophical dimensions of experience and philosophical issues in texts, and practice using Philosophy for Children curriculum materials. Time will also be dedicated to exploring some of the theoretical dimensions of Philosophy for Children, community of inquiry pedagogy, and philosophical curriculum construction.

Unique to the workshop this year will be break out sessions where inexperienced and experienced practitioners can work on developing their skills and understanding of the Philosophy for Children approaches most relevant to their particular level.

Workshop Costs: Room, board and cost of instruction is \$ 950.00 USD. (\$135 / day for visitors)
